

Dear Study Families,

Thank you for your support of Wimbledon Foodbank. Only with the help of the local community are we able to support families and individuals experiencing food poverty. We gratefully received your Harvest Festival donations, which weighed 488.4 kg, which will provide 627 meals to local people.

Wimbledon Foodbank works with families who are in crisis in the Merton area. For example, families who are coping with the day-to-day financial demands, until a crisis arises such as a broken boiler or a delay in benefits, redundancy could leave the family unable to feed themselves. The Foodbank will provide these families with three days of food and signpost them to the frontline professionals who can help solve the crisis.

250 voucher holders have now signed up and to date over 548 tons of food have been donated. We have fed 19,005 local people in the last 12 months, many of which are children. These figures were 275% increase on the year before and beyond our expectations when opening on 31st October 2011.

Thank you so much for your contribution, it will make a huge difference to the families which we work with and help us to continue supporting families in crisis!
