# The Study Association – Nearly New Uniform Terms & Conditions

## General Information

The Nearly New Uniform Shop is run by The Study Association. Sales are held once a term, usually in September, March and June.

We welcome all current logo, clean uniform, which is in good condition. If you have uniform to sell, please leave it in the School Office at Wilberforce House or Spencer House in a bag clearly marked 'Nearly New Uniform' in the week immediately preceding a sale. In particular new style winter coats, new style summer dresses, winter pinafores and winter skirts are always needed! A copy of the school uniform list is available in the School Handbook.

## Terms & Conditions

Please note, by sending in your goods you are deemed to have accepted these Terms & Conditions.

1. We hold regular sales, the dates of which are in the school calendar and newsletters. The shop will not be open in between these times.
2. The total value of goods bought from the shop must be paid for either in cash or cheque made payable to 'The Study Association' with your daughter's name on the back.
3. No goods may leave the shop unless fully paid for. We cannot 'hold' items for buyers nor can we exchange or take back items, although they can be resold by the buyer.
4. We quality check all donated items for suitability for sale. All non-current uniform and any items deemed unsalable (old, worn or faded, stained or ripped etc) will be passed to charity. Items are only disposed of after careful consideration but unfortunately it is not possible to inform the owners or return the items. If you want to check whether we will sell something, please call in to the sale.
5. Should you wish to receive cash back on eligible items you have donated, please ensure that each such item has an envelope with your daughter's name and class safety pinned to it. Any unnamed items will be considered a donation and if sold, the full amount retained by The Study Association.
6. The Study Association has a set pricing structure for all items, which is available on the Study website and on from the Class Reps. This is may be updated from time to time.
7. Sellers receive the fixed amount of cash back as set out on the price list on any eligible items which are sold.
8. Payment for goods sold will be sent back via your daughter. For children no longer at the school, payments will be posted if we have your current address. If you are leaving the school and moving it is your responsibility to advise us of your change of address.
9. The Study Association or their volunteers take no responsibility for any items held in the shop. Items are left entirely at the owner's risk.
